

**Department of State 2010 Construction Services for U.S. Embassy Bogota, Colombia**

**Notice of Solicitation of Submissions for Contractor Pre-Qualification**

THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF STATE (DOS), Bureau of Overseas Buildings Operations (OBO) is requesting submissions to pre-qualify firms for construction services for an upgrade to the site lighting system at the US embassy in Bogota, Colombia. The intention is to replace and supplement the existing site lights to provide a system that is in compliance with the latest DOS standards and codes. The project is described in detail in the construction documents (CDs). The work includes replacement of ground-mounted poles as well as mounting new light poles on the perimeter wall. Wall modifications will be required to properly support the wall-poles.

**Project Description:**

**SAQMMA-10-R0400 Bogota, Colombia**– Site Lighting Upgrade and Construction at the U.S. embassy in Bogota, Colombia. Estimated construction cost \$1 to \$2 million.

THE PROJECT SOLICITATIONS WILL CONSIST OF TWO PHASES. This announcement for pre-qualification is Phase I. The Department of State will evaluate and rate the pre-qualification proposals based on the evaluation criteria set forth in the established Evaluation Factors. Those offerors receiving a satisfactory evaluated rating from the technical board will be issued a formal solicitation (Request for Proposal) and invited to submit proposed pricing in Phase II.
