Questions and Answers 1
Dispatch and Driver and Administrative Support Services

- 1) Question: Ref Par 10.1 of the PWS “The Contractor shall provide transportation for all contractor employees, as required, to/from their place of residence and their place of work 24 hours a day/7 days a week. The U.S. Government shall not be responsible and shall not be charged separately for contractor employee transportation.”

Is it the government's intent to mandate the contractor provide daily "door to door" (home to office to home) internal company transportation services for the drivers, dispatchers and Admin personnel at contractor cost 24/7 in this PWS?

Please clarify if yes, contractor is to provide (company provided transportation/shuttle services) for "door to door" transportation of employees or provide a Transportation Subsidy (\$) allowance (in accordance with local labor laws), or other meaning.

Response: The contractor makes the determination on how to provide transportation for its employees to and from work. This requirement is due to the restrictions for vehicle access in some facilities and there is no available public transportation to get the employees to these facilities. Therefore, the contractor shall ensure the employees have transportation to get them to these restricted facilities.

The PWS will be revised as follows: “The contractor shall provide transportation for all contractor employees, as required, to enable them to access facilities where services are required. The U.S. Government shall not be responsible and shall not be charged separately for cost incurred.”
